- In this family service there will be games, crafts, activities, prayers a story and a baptism!




'Why are you here?'

In Christ Alone


In Christ alone my hope is found, He is my light, my strength, my song; This Cornerstone, this solid Ground, Firm through the fiercest drought and storm.




What heights of love, what depths of peace,

Scorned by the ones he came to save:




Till on that cross as Jesus died,

Bought with the precious blood of Christ.




No guilt in life, no fear in death, This is the power of Christ in me; From life's first cry to final breath. Jesus commands my destiny.






Great is Thy Faithfulness

As Thou hast been Thou forever wilt be












The Lord's Prayer






Before the throne of God above


Before the throne of God above

Who ever lives and pleads for me.




My name is graven on His hands, My name is written on His heart. I know that while in Heaven He stands No tongue can bid me thence depart No tongue can bid me thence depart
