His wounds have paid my ransom



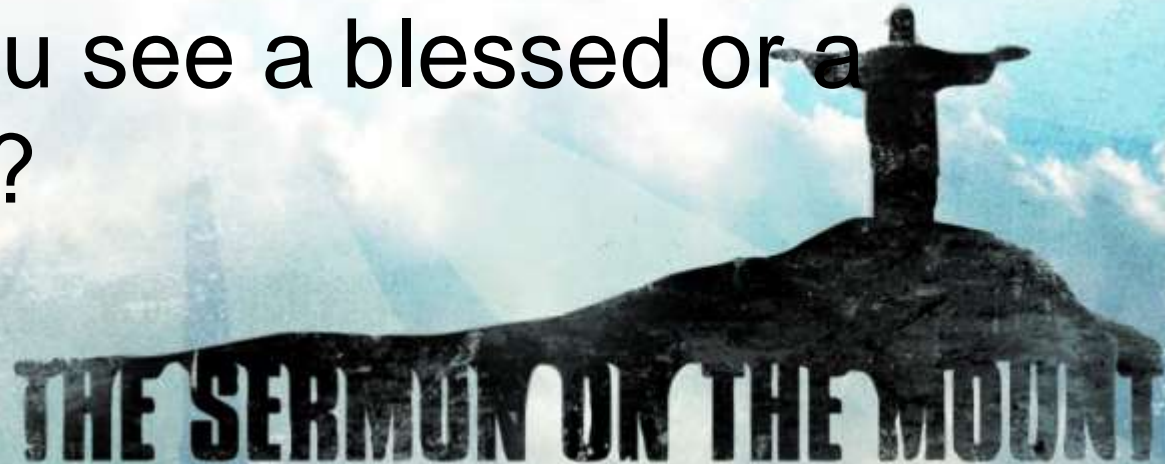

# The Lord's Prayer

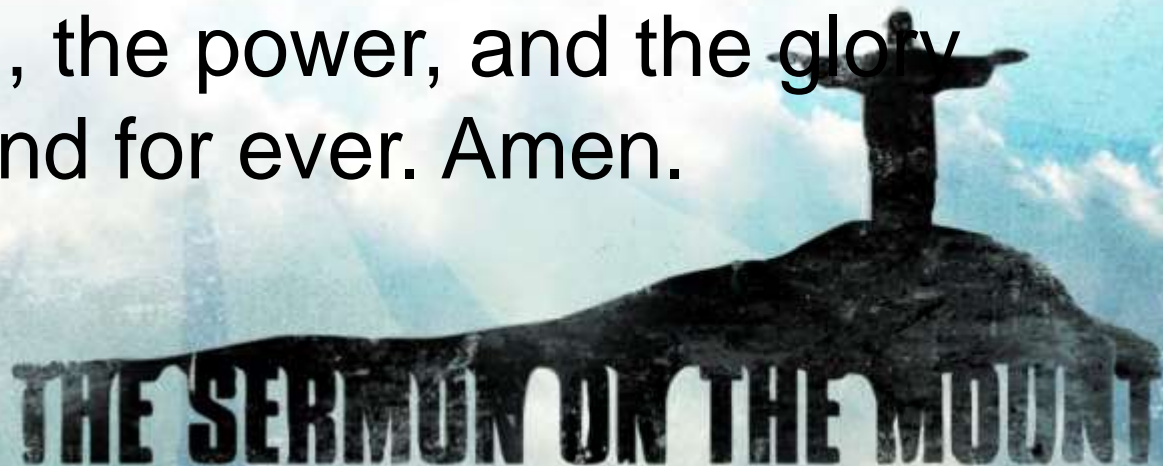


Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven.

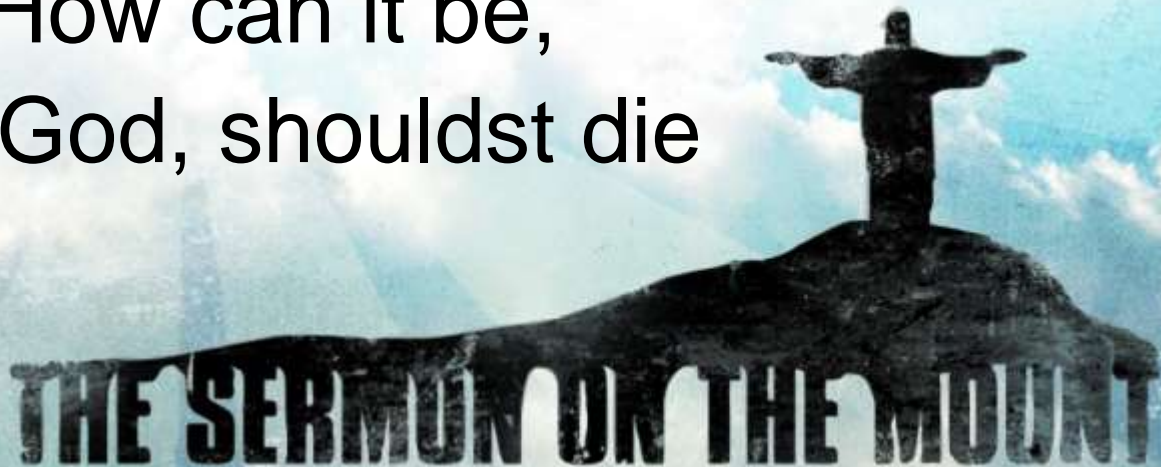

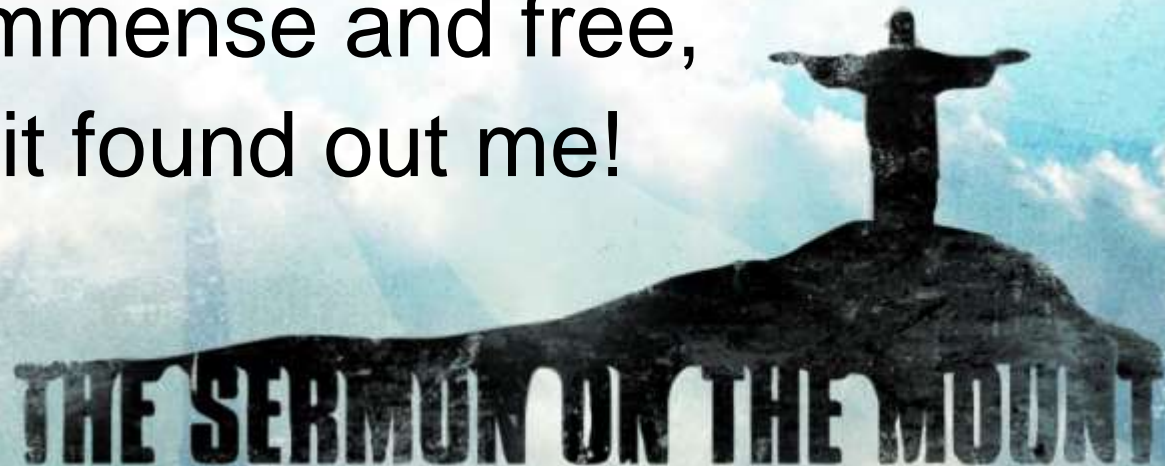
