Are for them who will trust and obey.

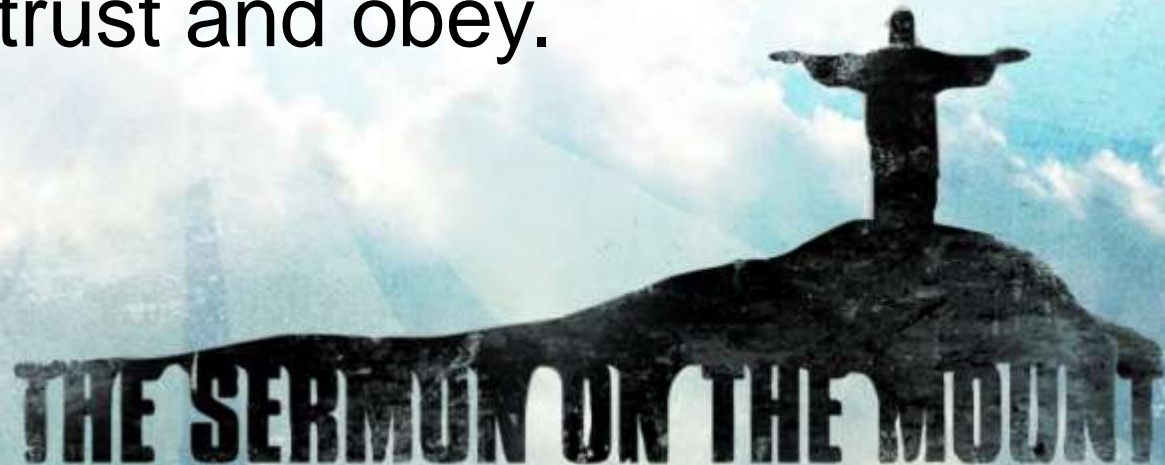

The Lord's Prayer

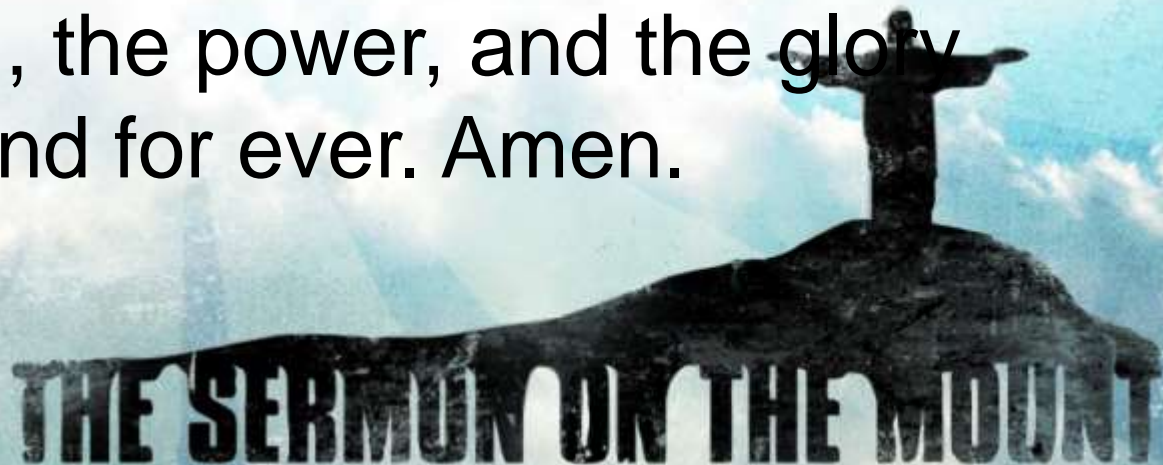


Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven.
