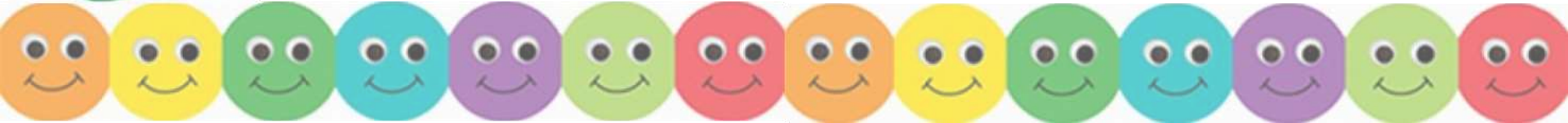


Free Flow!

- Group games (eg Elefun, shut the box, connect 4, dominoes, **card games** eg pairs)

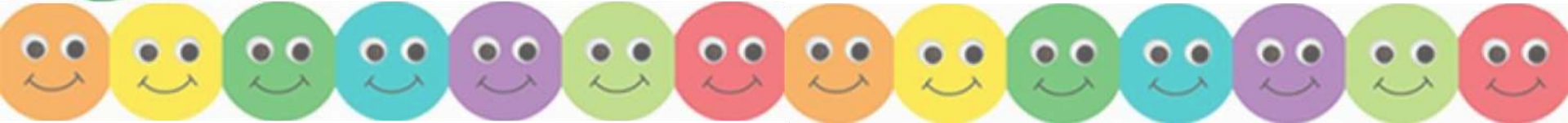


Matthew 6: 25 - 34



²⁵ “This is why I tell you: do not be worried about the food and drink you need in order to stay alive, or about clothes for your body. After all, isn't life worth more than food? And isn't the body worth more than clothes? ²⁶ Look at the birds: they do not plant seeds, gather a harvest and put it in barns; yet your Father in heaven takes care of them! Aren't you worth much more than birds? ²⁷ Can any of you live a bit longer by worrying about it?

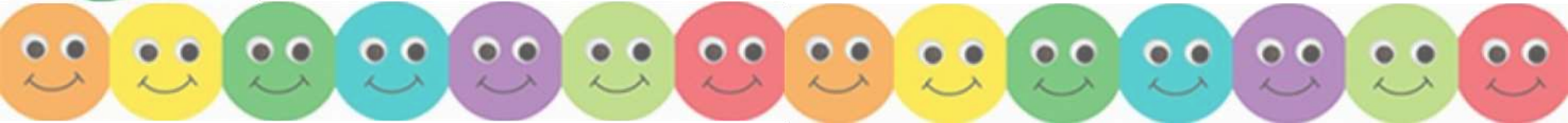
²⁸ “And why worry about clothes? Look how the wild flowers grow: they do not work or make clothes for themselves. ²⁹ But I tell you that not even King Solomon with all his wealth had clothes as beautiful as one of these flowers. ³⁰ It is God who clothes the wild grass—grass that is here today and gone tomorrow, burned up in the oven. Won't he be all the more sure to clothe you? What little faith you have!

³¹ “So do not start worrying: ‘Where will my food come from? or my drink? or my clothes?’ ³² (These are the things the pagans are always concerned about.) Your Father in heaven knows that you need all these things. ³³ Instead, be concerned above everything else with the Kingdom of God and with what he requires of you, and he will provide you with all these other things. ³⁴ So do not worry about tomorrow; it will have enough worries of its own. There is no need to add to the troubles each day brings.





Today's Key Points

Know what:

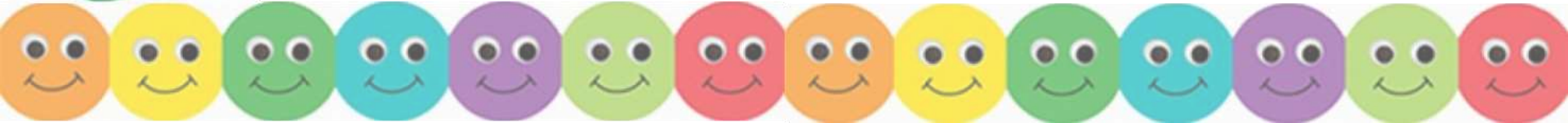
- Today we continue to look at the Sermon on the Mount, in which Jesus teaches his followers how to live.
- We have looked at the Beatitudes - eight attitudes that lead to a happy life - and Jesus' teaching on true treasure
- This week we look at the next part of Jesus' very practical teaching on worry.
- Jesus teaches that we should not be over anxious about what we eat or drink or about what we will wear. There is more to life than that! Jesus says that birds do not store up food in barns and flowers do not need to make themselves beautiful. God provides for them.
- Jesus says that we should focus first on God's rule in our lives and we will have all we need.
- Jesus also says we must not be over anxious about tomorrow. Each day has enough trouble of its own. It does not extend our lives.

So What:

- This teaching is about our priorities. Our consumer society pressurises us to focus on material things – the pester power of advertising on TV as an example. Jesus' radical teaching is not to be consumed by such things. Instead we should focus first on living God's way and everything else will fall into place.

Now what:

- It is really hard not to be completely engulfed by consumer pressure. Take time out to focus on what really drives your lifestyle. Do you need to change direction, put God first and trust him to let everything else fall into place?



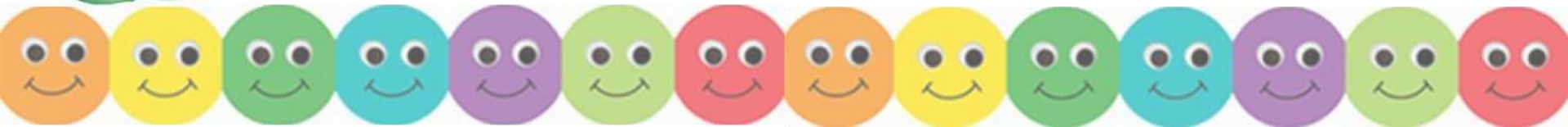
