

Key Points

Know What:

- Today is Palm Sunday, the day we celebrate Jesus' arrival into Jerusalem and the beginning of 'Holy Week'.
- Long before Jesus was born a man called Zechariah prophesied the coming of a king who would ride on a donkey. He said that it would be a time of celebration and beginning of a time of peace.
- Jesus sent his disciples to find him a donkey to ride on, a sign that he was a king who would bring peace.
- When he arrived some people took palm branches and waved them to welcome Jesus to the city. They shouted 'Hosanna' ('save us') and called Jesus 'son of David'. The whole of Jerusalem was asking who Jesus was.
- Other people were not pleased at Jesus' entry and began looking for ways to kill him. This was the beginning of the Easter story.

So What:

- God has kept his promise and brought a king to Jerusalem.
- People react to Jesus differently even today, some celebrate him as king, others are offended by him.

Now What:

- Let's celebrate Jesus as king.
- Let's prepare ourselves for Easter and the wonders that Jesus has done.
