## Know What:

- This week we are continuing our short series on Generosity and Stewardship.

- The woman was surprised because Jesus was a Jew and she was a Samaritan, they didn't usually get on. She asked Jesus a question that had been bothering her – was it right to worship on the mountain (like Samaritans do) or in the Temple (like Jews do)?
- Jesus said that one day the place that people worship won't matter anymore. Instead true worshipers will worship with their hearts.
