# Gonna Jump Up and Down


I'm gonna jump up and down



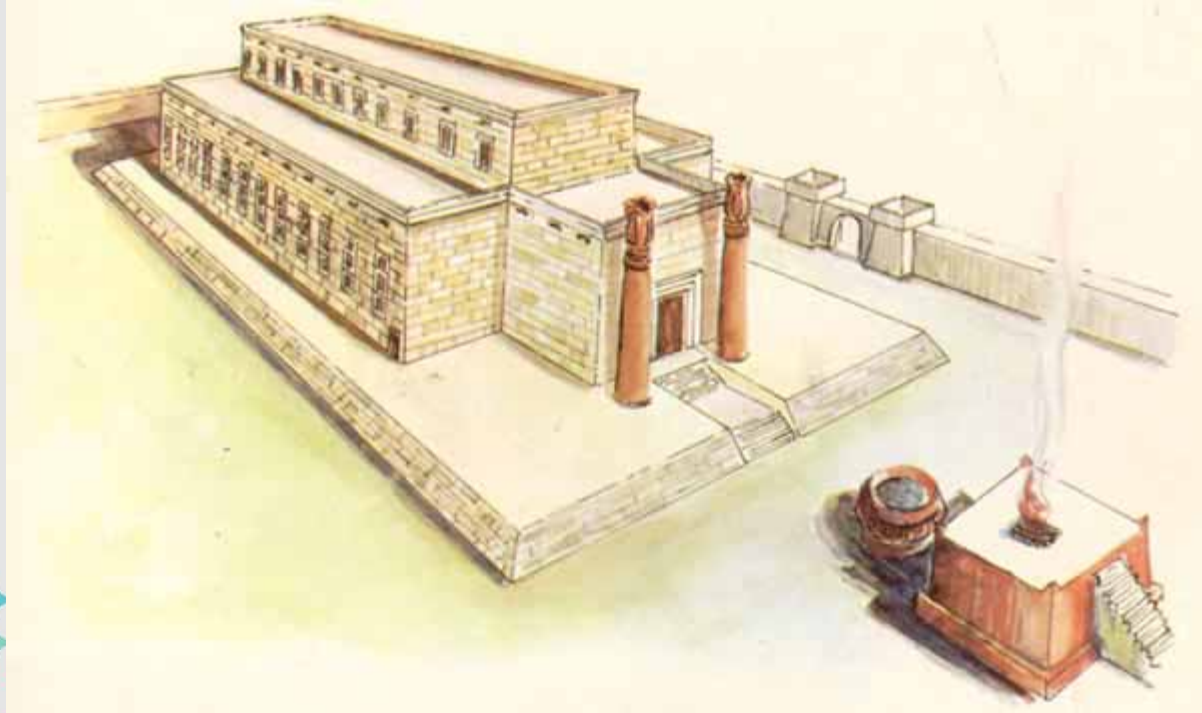

Some of us are very small


Some of us like pink and some like blue

That's because we're different,


